



Fathers-N-Flashlights 2024 Campout at Oak Meadow Park April 13-14, 2024

Please read all information in this packet *prior to arriving* at the event on Saturday afternoon. It contains important information to ensure a smooth camping experience.

CAMPSITE RULES

- Fathers and child(ren) are required to wear the official 2024 Fathers-N-Flashlights t-shirt while attending the event.
- All students attending Fathers-N-Flashlights **MUST BE** between the ages of 3 and 12.
- Your children must be supervised at all times.
- No alcohol, glass, fire, or incendiary devices will be allowed in the park for the Fathers-N-Flashlights event. Constables will be enforcing all state and local laws.
- This is a non-smoking/vaping. This is a smoke free event.
- No animals or pets will be allowed at this event.
- No foul and/or indecent language will be allowed.
- Children **MUST** sleep in a tent with their own parent or guardian. No friend sleepovers.
- Once the movie ends, it will be "lights out" throughout the park.
- No parking will be available at the event, you **MUST** be dropped off or arrive at Oak Meadow Park by foot. No motorized vehicles, such as golf carts, will be allowed at the campsite. *Please contact PTO President Brandy Renshaw at 281-881-8660 for any special needs or parking assistance.*
- We have an emergency evacuation policy in place. **If you have to leave the campsite for any reason, you MUST notify Brandy Renshaw, at 281-881-8660 so we can update the evacuation list.**

WHAT TO PACK

- Cooler with extra drinks/snacks for you and your children
- Lantern/Flashlights/Headlamps
- Blankets/Chairs for movie
- Tent with Stakes
- Tarp for Under Tent
- Mallet or Hammer for Stakes
- Sleeping Bags and Pillows
- Essential Toiletries and Medications
- Extra socks!!
- Disinfecting Wipes or Gel
- Bug Spray
- Sunscreen
- Additional Personal Trash Bags
- Fishing Gear, Balls, Frisbees, etc.
- Warm Jackets and/or Rain Gear
- Rolling cart or wagon to carry gear to campsite

CHECK-IN PROCESS - SATURDAY, APRIL 13

1:30 PM – 2:30 PM: King of the Hill

3:00 PM – 4:00 PM: Happy Camper

Check in ends at 6 PM

- You will your FNF t-shirts the week of the camp out. Shirts will be sent home with students. **FNF shirts must be worn at all times.**
- Officers and volunteers will be directing the traffic flow upon arrival. Please follow their instructions. **NO CELL PHONE USE IN CAR LINE DROP OFF.**
- You will not be allowed to enter except during your designated check in time – no early arrivals.
- Please have all items you plan to unload easily accessible and ready. We strongly recommend you have your own wagon packed and in your vehicle.
- Kids **MUST** remain inside the vehicle until it is completely unloaded.
- The person dropping you off is allowed to help you unload items and children from the car, but he/she must be prepared to leave immediately after the vehicle is unloaded. We need to keep the car line moving and allow for an efficient continuous flow of cars checking in. There will **NOT** be anywhere to park your car.
- **YOU MUST check in and complete the waivers before you may proceed onto the campsite.** Once unloaded, proceed immediately to camper check-in.
- Once you have completed your check-in process and received your family's tent sign, please choose your preferred camping site and set up.
