### Submitting Pictures to the Yearbook

Have some great shots from activities during the school year? The Yearbook Committee would love to have you share them with us! All pictures should be submitted no later than 10 days following the event.

- There are two ways you can submit:
  - 1. Upload via Balfour's website: images.balfour.com using your phone or computer (RECOMMENDED)
  - 2. Upload the Balfour ImageShare app
- Our "Project Number" is: 427093 and leave the "Upload Code" blank
- You can only upload 10 images at a time, so it may take more than one upload if you have a lot. JPEG files preferred; HEIC files may be too large and give you an error.
- Be detailed in your names and captions
  - o Name: John Smith, Jane Doe, 2nd Grade, Ms. Jones
  - o Caption: Meet the Teacher
- You can list as many names as you know in the name section. You can always ask your student to help you identify who is in the picture they'll know names, even if it's just a first name.


# Checking your PTO Account & Order Information

- Click Select Photos
- Choose up to 10 images and click Open
- Enter the names and information about the photos
- Click Upload Photos
- Your photos will be uploaded directly to the yearbook staff Note: The yearbook staff will review all photos & determine final yearbook content. We cannot guarantee that all submissions can be used in the book.

**Pro Tip:** Use the same email address to login on any device to see previous uploads in the History tab.
