



Fathers-N-Flashlights 2026 “Know Before You Go” Packet

Campout at Oak Meadow Park March 28-29, 2026

Please read all information in this packet *prior to arriving* at the event on Saturday afternoon. It contains important information to ensure a smooth camping experience.

CAMPSITE RULES

- **Adults will be required to present ID to check in at the campsite.** Camping packages are not transferable to other families. The park area is closed to visitors.
- **NO alcohol, glass, fire, or incendiary devices will be allowed in the park for the Fathers-N-Flashlights event.** Constables will be enforcing all state and local laws.
- **This is a non-smoking/vaping event.** Please leave these items at home.
- No animals or pets will be allowed at this event.
- No foul and/or indecent language will be allowed.
- Fathers and child(ren) are required to wear the official 2026 Fathers-N-Flashlights t-shirt while attending the event. All students attending Fathers-N-Flashlights **MUST BE** between the ages of 3 and 12.
- Your children must be supervised at all times.
- Children **MUST** sleep in a tent with their own parent or guardian. No friend sleepovers.
- Once the movie ends, it will be "lights out" throughout the park.
- **No parking will be available at the event, you MUST be dropped off or arrive at Oak Meadow Park on foot.** No motorized vehicles, such as golf carts, will be allowed at the campsite. *Please contact the PTO at fnf@popepto.org for any special needs or parking assistance.*
- We have an emergency evacuation policy in place. **If you have to leave the campsite for any reason, you MUST notify our Camp Director, Jennie Hemphill, at 832-279-5817 so we can update the evacuation list.**

WHAT TO PACK

- Cooler with extra drinks/snacks for you and your children
- Sleeping Bags, Blankets, Pillows, Air/Foam Mattress
- Sunscreen
- Lantern/Flashlights/Headlamps
- Essential Toiletries and Medications
- Additional Personal Trash Bags
- Blankets/Chairs for movie
- PJs and Extra socks!!
- Fishing Gear, Balls, Frisbees, Games, etc.
- Tent with Stakes
- Disinfecting Wipes or Hand-sanitizing Gel
- Warm Jackets and/or Rain Gear, if needed
- Tarp for Under Tent
- Bug Spray
- Rolling cart or wagon to carry gear to campsite
- Mallet or Hammer for Stakes

CHECK-IN PROCESS - SATURDAY, MARCH 28

1:30 PM – 2:30 PM: King of the Hill

3:00 PM – 4:00 PM: Happy Camper

Check in ends at 6 PM

- You will receive your FNF t-shirts the week of the camp out. Shirts and waivers/emergency contact forms will be sent home with students. **FNF shirts must be worn at all times.**
- Officers and volunteers will be directing the traffic flow upon arrival. Please follow their instructions. **NO CELL PHONE USE IN CAR LINE DROP OFF.**
- You will not be allowed to enter except during your designated check in time – no early arrivals.
- Please have all items you plan to unload easily accessible and ready. We strongly recommend you have your own wagon packed and in your vehicle.
- Kids **MUST** remain inside the vehicle until it is completely unloaded.
- The person dropping you off is allowed to help you unload items and children from the car, but he/she must be prepared to leave immediately after the vehicle is unloaded. We need to keep the car line moving and allow for an efficient continuous flow of cars to check in. There will **NOT** be anywhere to park your car.
- **YOU MUST CHECK IN to (1) turn in your completed waiver/emergency contact form, (2) pick up your family sign, and (3) get your dinner wristbands before you may choose a campsite.**
