WHAT IS IT?

Penny Wars is a fundraiser where teams compete for the most points. Students/families bring in pennies to place in their team jar for positive points and silver coins to decrease the amount of points in other jars.

We will be competing with Rennell and Warner Elementary and all proceeds outside our costs will be DONATED to CFISD Jr. Police Academy! C.O.P.S./Junior Police Academy (cfisd.net)

HOW IT WORKS/RULES:

- Students are divided into grade-level teams and each grade is assigned a collection jar. Warner and Rennell will also have a collection jar with the grade level ones.
- Jars will be located in the middle hallways on the first and second floors each morning from **8:20 8:45AM**.
- Pennies are positive points. All other currency (silver coins) are negative points. <u>Strategy tip:</u> Place silver coins in opposing team jars to sabotage them!
- The money in each class jar will be counted daily and the points tallied. Point standings will be announced at the end of each school day.
- The Grades in PK-2 and Grades 3-5 who have the most points at the end of the week will win a **VERY SPECIAL TREAT!**

ACADEMIC CONNECTIONS

- Students learn to differentiate coin value.
- Students practice counting money.
- Builds classroom camaraderie.
- New vocabulary strategy, competition, SABOTAGE

PRACTICE AT HOME

- Practice identifying money values and counting money. Older students can practice converting money to Penny War points.
- Have your child total the points that they are planning to donate to their grade level jar. Review the end of day tally sheet to see how many of the total points they contributed.

POINT VALUES:

- Penny: (+) Add 1 point
- Nickel: (-) Subtract 5 points
- Dime: (-) Subtract 10 points
- Quarter: (-) Subtract 25 points
